Milk

Milk for the next half term is £5.00. If you wish your child to have milk, please pay on SchoolMoney by Thursday, 8th February so that we can order the correct amount. Children are entitled to free milk until the week before their 5th birthday or if on income-based free school meals. (Nb. You will see an outstanding payment for milk on screen when you log in to SchoolMoney, you only need to pay this if your child would like milk and they are not entitled to free milk, otherwise you can ignore it).

Free School Meal Vouchers for February Half Term

Worcestershire County Council are paying for a £15 food voucher to cover the half term holiday for all children who are entitled to income based free school meals (this does not include Universal Free School Meals which all children from Reception to Year 2 are entitled to). Vouchers will be sent out via email at the beginning of the half term week. If you think you may be entitled to free school meals and haven't applied yet please apply via Worcestershire County Council's website, even if your child does not want the meal or they are already receiving Universal Free School Meals. The extra funding we get enables us to support our children and families in a range of ways other than simply providing free school meals. For example, we have used it for employing an additional intervention teacher, providing reading and writing intervention programmes and supporting children with speech and language difficulties.
